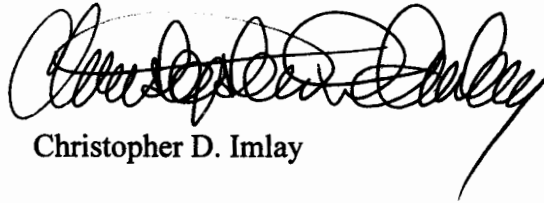
Broadcast Sports, Incorporated of Crofton, Maryland will soon file an application with the FCC seeking Special Temporary Authority for use of the bands 2300-2308 and 2390-2398 MHz, for wideband video transmission at low power (200 mW output, 1 watt ERP peak, using 8M00D7D emission) in the area of the Daytona Motor Speedway, Daytona, Florida during the period February 9, 2006 through February 20, 2006. This is to permit the use of in-car RF cameras at the Daytona 500 automobile race. The coordinates of the speedway are 29-11-02 North, and 81-04-04 West.

Having checked the bandplan and the repeater directory, it is reasonably certain that there are no fixed facilities in this area in either band that require notification or which might suffer interference. However, the 2304 MHz segment is used substantially during microwave and UHF contests, none of which are scheduled during this time period. Nevertheless, please post this event on the ARRL web page so that any licensed amateurs who might be using the 2304 MHz segment during that period will know the source of any interference. Because of the nature of this operation, any interference is highly unlikely. A copy of this is being sent to the Florida Repeater Council at the address in the Repeater Directory, to deal with any unpublished fixed links or other narrowband or wideband amateur operations in the area.

Should any Amateur report interference from this short term operation, please notify either the undersigned, at (301) 384-5525 or Peter Larsson of Broadcast Sports,

Inc. at 410-672-3900 and operation will cease in this band unless and until the interference is resolved.
