Broadcast Sports Inc. ("BSI") hereby request that the above referenced application for Special Temporary Authority ("STA") be dismissed-without prejudice.

On February 27, 2008, BSI filed its initial STA request for a UHF channel (channel 19, File No 0090-EX-ST-2008) in Darlington, SC, which was granted March 28, 2008. During further coordination of the NASCAR event the local Society of Broadcast Engineer ("SBE") coordinator indicated that channel 19 would pose a problem due to traffic and a possibility of interference. With that information BSI request a second STA for channel 18. The local SBE coordinator has now informed BSI that our initial request for use of channel 19 is clear to use. The STA application for channel 18 is not longer needed as BSI will use the UHF channel 19 initial requested.

It is with this that BSI request that the above reference application be Dismissed-Without Prejudice.
