Broadcast Sports (“BSI” or “applicant”) has commissioned a study of television broadcast channel occupancy within the frequency ranges 488-494 MHz (Ch 17) and found that there were no stations within 100 miles of the course in Bloomfield, MI (42-32-42N/83-16-36W). Likewise a study was performed to identify all TV stations operating within 100 miles in the course. *See attached.*

Due to the low power operation of BSI at this each event no interference is anticipated. Should any interference be reported however, applicant will cease use of said bands immediately until remedied.
