

JUSTIFICATION STATEMENT

Pursuant to Section 74.24 of the rules of the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") Broadcast Sports Inc. ("BSI" or "Applicant"), respectfully requests Special Temporary Authority ("STA") for short term operation on two (2) AFTRCC frequencies in the 1.4 GHz (1505 and 1525 MHz) band at the Raymond James Stadium in Miami, FL for a short-term operation period of two (2) days from October18 thru October19, 2008. The purpose of this SAT is to test and demo new equipment for future use. The equipment will enable BSI to provide video and audio production and communications for the television broadcast networks and security personnel in and around the stadium (27-58-36N/082-30-12W). The safety of stadium officials and spectators are of the utmost concerns therefore making video cameras and mobile handheld units essential leading up to, the day of and after the event.

Applicant has coordinated all spectrum use requested herein with AFTRCC, which coordinates flight test telemetry operations on the subject channels. See attached.

Due to the Applicant's proposed low out-power and ERP, no interference is anticipated. Should any interference be reported, Applicant will cease use of any portion of the requested bands immediately, unless and until remedied.

Applicant respectfully requests a waiver of the Office of Engineering and Technology's policy requiring 30-day notice for filing STA applications. The delay in submitting the STA request is due the last minute contract negotiation and thus the applicant filed as soon as it was possible. It is with this that applicant request expedited review and grant of the STA.
