This application proposes to use numerous frequency bands allocated to radio services other than LTTS or BAS. In the case of 2180-2197 MHz, applicant will avoid interference to any Mobile Satellite Service receive sites or terrestrial components or grandfathered fixed and mobile facilities due to the location of the proposed operation, at the shore and aboard watercraft in San Francisco Bay, and the low power operation proposed.

Coordination with ARRL, the national Association for Amateur Radio, has been completed relative to the 2300-2308 MHz band and the 2390-2400 MHz segment. There will be no interference to incumbent MWS Part 27 licensees in the 2305-2308 MHz segment due to the location of the proposed operation and the low power levels.

AFTRCC coordination has been completed relative to the 2360-2390 MHz segment.

Finally, no interference to grandfathered Channel A10 BAS incumbents at 2483.5-2500 MHz, and all operation will be coordinated with the Northern California Frequency Coordination Committee, which is affiliated with the Society of Broadcast Engineers. Any non-BAS incumbents such as relocated MDS licensees will be protected in this band, which is still actively used by BAS grandfathered incumbents in any case.
