This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

Special Temporary Authority is hereby granted to operate the apparatus described below:

To provide sufficient video paths for communications for RF cameras at each part of this golf tournament for video production of this televised golf event.

Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) The applicant must coordinate with the incumbent Advanced Wireless Service (AWS) licensee(s) to avoid interference in the 2110-2155 MHz band, AWS-3 in 2155-2180 MHz and AWS-4 in 2180-2200 MHz in each corresponding proposed venue prior to conducting the testing.
- (4) The authorized station must be in compliance with the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) requirements as set forth in Section 17.4 of the Commission's Rules.
- (5) The authorized station must be in compliance with environmental requirement set forth in Section 1.1307 of the Commission's Rules.
- (6) Experimental station shall use the minimum power level necessary to establish communications links to minimize potential interference to licensed users.
- (7) This authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future experimental satellite earth station applications.
- (8) Operations are on a non-interference basis (NIB) and shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from, interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating station and it shall cease transmission(s) immediately upon notice of such interference and notify the FCC in writing.
- (9) Broadcast Sports International should be aware that the band 2200-2290 MHz is allocated for federal operations and is a highly congested band. Non-federal use is on a case-by-case basis. Broadcast Sports International should have no expectations of automatic approval in this band in future submissions.
