Narrative Explanation of Operation
United States Open Golf Tournament
Oakmont Country Club, Oakmont, PA
June 12, 2016 through June 19, 2016

This application proposes the use of the band 2200-2290 MHz for short-range video relay in connection with video production by the applicant of the U.S. Open Golf Tournament to be held at the Oakmont Country Club located at 1233 Hulton Road, Oakmont, PA between June 12 and 19 inclusive, 2016. This period includes setup and testing prior to the event. This is a major golf tournament televised worldwide. This STA application is identical to that granted for the venue of the U.S. Open Golf Tournament in Chambers Bay, University Place, Washington last year. See, WI9XNZ, File No. 0480-EX-ST-2015.

Should any authorized entity using this band report interference during the proposed operations, operation on the offending channel will immediately cease and not resume unless and until the interference complaint is resolved to the satisfaction of the authorized user.

Other licensed channels normally used for video production in this frequency range are not available for this event due to their use by other licensees and authorized services.
