This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

Special Temporary Authority is hereby granted to operate the apparatus described below:

Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) All operations in the 1435-1452 MHz band shall comply with the limits of unwanted emission recommendations specified in ITU Resolution 750 (Rev. WRC-19).
- (4) Frequency assignment(s) in the bands of 1435-1525 MHz and 2360-2395 MHz must be coordinated prior to authorization with the DoD USAF AFC (Area Frequency Coordinator), DoD MIDLANT AFC, DoD Western AFC, and DoD AFMO-US&P who also coordinate, as appropriate, with Aerospace and Flight Test Radio Coordinating Council. Use of these frequencies under the authority is subject to such further coordination with the AFC to ensure compatibility with existing users.
- (5) Non-interference basis to all Flight Test telemetry missions and no protection afforded to Broadcast Sports Intl operations.
- (6) Unprotected NIB operations are under an XT or MO station class
- (7) STOP BUZZER POC provided with cell and land line contact information that can cease any and all Broadcast Sports Intl emissions if EMI is detected.
