Gentlemen:

This request for STA is made on behalf of our client, **BST, Inc.**, a manufacturer and provider of video transmission equipment for remote video and film production at sporting events, and in particular, automobile racing competitions. Your office has granted on prior occasions special temporary authority to utilize certain frequencies at 2.3 and 2.4 GHz for video production purposes, conditioned on coordination with the Aeronautical Flight Test Telemetry Coordination Council (AFTRCC).

Further special temporary authorization is hereby requested for operation at the location and dates listed in **Exhibit A**, attached herewith for the purpose of video production for this year's Super Bowl. The coordination with AFTRCC has been conducted and all appropriate fees have been paid. A copy of that coordination is attached as **Exhibit B**.

The frequencies and power levels are as follows:

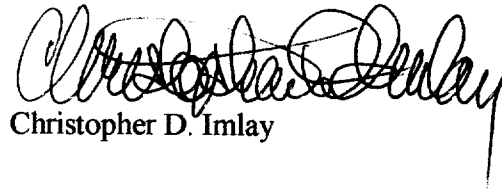
The video transmitters are TVT-50 units. The camera/transmitters will be utilized within the football stadium. BST will charge fees for the video production services performed.
