Peter,

Eglin AFB Frequency Management has re-evaluated the request for the use of the "L" band for the Seniors Golf Tourney (see note below).

They now realize that your proposed operation has negligible chance of interfering with possible operations at Eglin. They are concerned though, if they were to operate at the time of the event, particularly on Thursday and Friday, that they could likely interfere with your operation.

I don't believe they understand that BST would have only secondary use of the band and would have to accept any interference from a military operation. I trust you understand that this is the case.

I'm impressed by Lee's concern for your proposed operation, and I'm sure you understand that the primary use of this band is for aircraft testing requiring the transfer of data from the test aircraft to a ground station. I believe that BST could reduce or eliminate the risk of interference by the positioning of the receiving antenna to block possible signals being emanated from the direction of Eglin with respect to Pensacola.

I would be willing to inform Lee that BST is willing to accept the risk of interference. Before I do that, I wanted to present this information to you. If this is acceptable, I'll pursue coordination of the conditional use with Eglin Frequency Management.

This is the conclusion arrived at by the DoD Gulf AFC, Mr
Giangrosso:

The use of the band for Thursday and Friday, 28-29 March, 2002, would be at high risk for this event. The use of a 15db monopole antenna with 1.5 watts at ground would not interfere with Eglin's operation, however, the reverse is not the case. The high power TM transmitters operating at altitude coupled with the sensitivity of the event based receivers will most likely lead to interference from Eglin's operations. At this point we are unable to forecast the density of the Eglin operation, however, with any test mission on the Eglin range, the line of sight calculations do note possible interference to the operation of the events' TV system.

Operation during the first two days of the event would be in jeopardy. Records note that there is a good probability that no operations will be scheduled by Eglin for the 30-31 March part of the schedule and thus the TV broadcast should be able to operate interference free.

Recommendation: Develop a backup strategy for the first two days of the event to operate on an alternate higher-frequency band.
