This request for STA is made on behalf of our client, BST, Inc., formerly known as Broadcast Sports Technology (BST), a manufacturer and provider of video transmission equipment for remote video and film production at sporting events, and in particular, automobile racing competitions. 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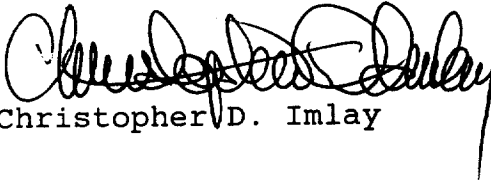
The frequencies are the same as in the prior STAs (2316, 2333, 2350, 2367, 2384 and 2496.0 MHz at all locations). The power level is the same as prior STAs (2.5 watts output). The video transmitters are TVT-50 units. The camera/transmitters will be installed in race vehicles.
