Gentlemen:

This request for STA is made on behalf of our client, **BST, Inc.**, a manufacturer and provider of video transmission equipment for remote video and film production at sporting events, and in particular, automobile racing competitions. Your office has granted on prior occasions special temporary authority to utilize certain frequencies at 2.3 and 2.4 GHz for video production purposes, conditioned on coordination with the Aeronautical Flight Test Telemetry Council (AFTRCC).

Further special temporary authorization is hereby requested for operation at the locations and dates listed in **Exhibit A**, attached herewith. The coordination with AFTRCC is now being conducted and all appropriate fees have been paid. We expect that the coordination with AFTRCC

will be completed soon and understand that confirmation of coordination is a pre-condition to this STA. We will file evidence of coordination with your good offices once received from AFTRCC.

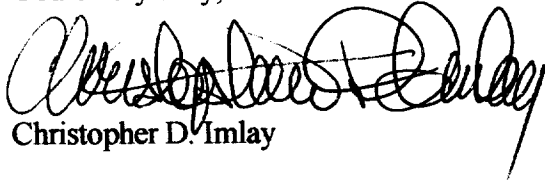
The video transmitters are TVT-50 units. The camera/transmitters will be installed in race vehicles. BST will charge fees for the video production services performed.

AFTRCC provides recommendations to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) for non-government use of flight test voice and telemetry frequencies. AFTRCC's role is strictly advisory; in all cases the FCC makes the decision whether to issue a license.

Applicants are advised that no representations or warranties, express or implied, are made as to the interference-free nature of any given frequency or frequencies which AFTRCC coordinates, or as to whether any given frequency recommendation is best suited for the Applicant's purposes.

Applicants should also be aware that frequencies coordinated by AFTRCC are shared with other users; no one user is entitled to exclusive use of a frequency in any given area. Multiple users may be, and often are, licensed or have government assignments for use of the same frequencies. Hence, notwithstanding FCC issuance of a license to the Applicant, transmission on any given frequency may be subject to day-to-day, hour-by-hour scheduling with Government Area Frequency Coordinators (AFCs) or other agencies.
