On behalf of our client, BST, Inc., we hereby seek a Special Temporary Authorization (STA) to utilize certain frequencies at 2.3 and 2.4 GHz for video production purposes. The STA will be expressly conditioned on coordination with the Aeronautical Flight Test Radio Coordination Council (AFTRCC).

BST is a manufacturer and provider of video transmission equipment for remote video and film production at sporting events and automobile racing competitions in particular. It has previously been granted STAs for specific racing events, conditioned upon prior AFTRCC coordination. BST now seeks extension of its previous STA in order to conduct similar operations on the dates, times, and places listed on **EXHIBIT A**. As shown in that attachment, BST proposes to operate on five frequencies (2316, 2350, 2333, 2367 and 2384 MHz) with a power output of 1.5 watts. The camera/transmitters are to be installed in race vehicles.

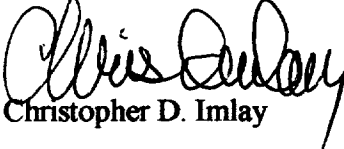
