This special temporary authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This special temporary authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control by the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

This request for STA is made on behalf of our client, BST, Inc., formerly known as Broadcast Sports Technology (BST), a manufacturer and provider of video transmission equipment for remote video and film production at sporting events, and in particular, automobile racing competitions. Your office granted on January 17, 1997 special temporary authority to utilize certain frequencies at 2.3 and 2.4 GHz for video production purposes, conditioned on coordination with the Aeronautical Flight Test Telemetry Council (AFTRCC). 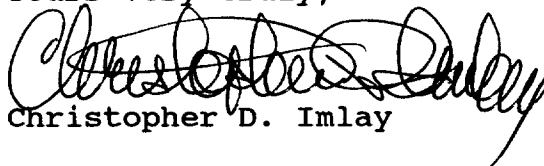
The frequencies are the same as in the immediately prior STA (2316, 2333, 2350, 2367, 2384 and 2496.0 MHz at all locations). The power level is the same as prior STAs (2.5 watts output). The video transmitters are TVT-50 units. The camera/transmitters will be installed in race vehicles.

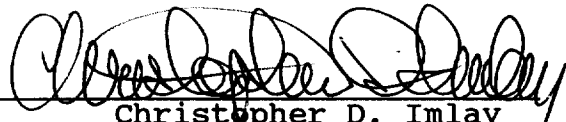
