Special Conditions:

- (4) Any operation of an INMARSAT satellite earth station that goes beyond Part 5 of the Commission's Rules is prohibited. Separate temporary or permanent authorization for any such operations must be received from the International Bureau of the Federal Communications Commission. Grant of this experimental authorization in no way prejudices the outcome of any future licensing proceeding for permanent authority to operate INMARSAT terminals in the U.S. Satellite earth station end users shall be notified of this condition and that until permanent authority to operate the INMARSAT terminals within the U.S. has been issued, the terminals may be required to cease operations.
