This is to inform Comsat Mobile, the FCC and Inmarsat of the intent of use for CNN Inmarsat A terminals *within the United States* already commissioned as follows:

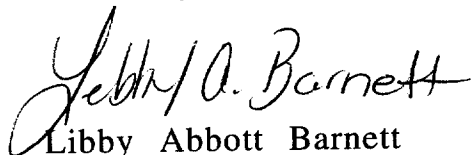
MTI TCS 9000 I.D. number 153 6315 and 6316,

Magnavox MX 2400 I.D. number 150 7561 and 7562

CNN intends to use this terminals cover breaking news stories in areas where cell phones or standard phone service would be unavailable or areas struck by a catastrophe (i.e. earthquake, flooding etc).. Due to the nature of our business it is essential to have communications capability during a crisis when existing means of communications are no longer available. These units will be based at the CNN bureaus in Los Angeles and San Francisco.

The terminals will be operated by CNN personnel for voice, fax and data communications back to our headquarters in Atlanta Georgia U.S.A. These terminals are already commissioned for use overseas. Attached is our Form 442 application to the FCC for a license to operate these units in the domestick U.S.
