We understand the Irvine satellite operators are requesting some input from the 18 SPCS. Here's our response:

I am the primary point of contact for the 18th Space Control Squadron (18 SPCS) Space Situational Awareness (SSA) Sharing. We have been in touch with the faculty advisors for the Irvine CubeSat STEM Program (ICSP), and have shared our procedures for maneuverable satellites with them, as seen in our Spaceflight Safety Handbook for Operators (at https://www.space-track.org/documents/JSpOC_Spaceflight_Safety_Handbook_For_Operators.pdf). We plan to provide the same tracking and conjunction assessment support for them as we would for any other active maneuverable satellite.
