The State of California (State) is requesting a modification to experimental license WK2XAZ. We have changed the initial frequency 401.9575 MHz to 401.7895 MHz. The GOES Satellite transmitter is located at the Sacramento Weir Telemetry site in Yolo County California. The telemetry site is part of a larger system operated by the State, which includes but is not limited to WA2XAJ, WC2XOB, and WI2XDU. The purpose of the site is to monitor water level, water temperature, wind speed, and other data for the area. The data is transmitted to the GOES satellite and is collected by the State's Department of Water Resources.
