Your statement, "Our objective, as a member of the Advanced Rural Communications Consortium, is to introduce new wireless services to our members and to underserved areas within a four county area.", raises our concerns that Canby Telephone Association may be attempting to establish a service in the 1910-1920 MHz band. Is it the long-term plan of Canby Telephone Association to terminate the use of the 1910-1920 MHz band and return to objectives in the licensed PCS bands upon completion of the experiment proposed in application 0049-EX-PL-2003?
