

PUBLIC INTEREST STATEMENT

1. Introduction

By the underlying application, CapRock Government Solutions, Inc. (“CapRock”) requests that the Federal Communications Commission grant special temporary authority (“STA”) to allow CapRock to operate the facilities specified in the application. STA is requested for a period of six (6) months.

2. Purpose and Nature of the Operation

CapRock provides end-to-end communications to support the mission-critical operations of its defense, intelligence, and government organization customers. CapRock’s primary focus is satellite communication services, terrestrial networks and professional services provides a wide array of command, control and communications capabilities. Specific information regarding the nature and purpose of this experiment, and other technical information, is contained in a Confidential Exhibit 3, with such Exhibit subject to a separately-filed Confidentiality Request.

3. Frequencies of Operation

CapRock intends to operate the proposed testing in the X-band within the following frequency ranges:

Uplink: 8280-8300 MHz

Downlink: 8077-8177
