

Exhibit 2 – Request to Modify WI2XXL

Carnegie Mellon University (“CMU”) is the holder of WI2XXL, an experimental radio license covering the use of certain frequencies in and around CMU’s Main Campus in Pittsburgh, PA and Moffett Field, CA. The license is for the purpose of testing TV white spaces and is subject to certain conditions. Further, CMU has established a stop buzzer point of contact for this license.

CMU is filing a request to modify this license to add the LoRa Traffic Dot v1.0 experimental radio (200 units) to transmit on 430-440 MHz and 902-928 MHz, as specified in filed Form 442. This radio will also be used to test TV white spaces and will be operated in conjunction with the same stop buzzer point of contact.
