Request for Modified Special Temporary Authority ("STA")

Dear Sir or Madam:

This is a request to amend CAVU's existing STA, call sign WA9XJF, a copy of which is enclosed, to perform the following modification:

Add 38.6 - 40.0 GHz channel pair 1A/B:

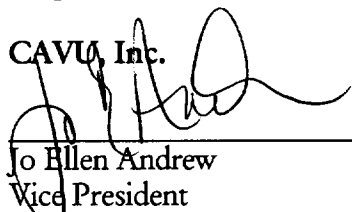
1(A) 38,600 - 38,650 MHz
1(B) 39,300 - 39,350 MHz

This change would result in CAVU having STA authority, expiring on December 7, 2000, for 39 GHz channel pairs 1 and 6. No other changes to the current STA are proposed. 39 GHz channel pair 1A/B was obtained in the FCC's recent Auction Event No. 30 by WinStar Wireless Fiber Corp. CAVU pledges that it will protect WinStar's use of channel pair 1A/B from harmful electrical interference.

CAVU certifies that it is not subject to the denial of federal benefits pursuant to the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988. Based on the foregoing, CAVU respectfully requests that the FCC issue modified STA for CAVU to test and operate its equipment in the 39 GHz frequency band.
