Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee is required to ensure that trial devices are either rendered inoperable or retrieved by them from trial participants at the conclusion of the trial. Licensee is required to notify trial participants in advance that operation of the trial device is subject to this condition.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (4) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (5) All transmitting and/or receiving equipment used in the study shall be owned by the licensee.
- (6) Licensee be aware that FSS earth stations are licensed above 3700 MHz and if any interference occurs, the experimental licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (7) Maintain operation separation from the grandfathered earth stations as defined in Part 90, Subpart Z, or coordinate an agreement with the grandfathered earth station licensees prior to operation in 3650-3700 MHz band.
- (8) Consult the ULS database to ensure that the operation will not cause harmful interference to any existing registered stations in the 3650-3700 MHz band, and notify the registered users in the proposed geographic areas.
- (9) Licensee may not involve more than 300 of its customers in this market trial.
