This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. Special Conditions:

- (1) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) Maintain operation separation from the grandfathered earth stations as defined in Part 90, Sub-part Z, or coordinate an agreement with the grandfathered earth station licensees prior to operation in 3650-3700 MHz band.
- (4) Consult the ULS database to ensure that the operation will not cause harmful interference to any existing registered stations in the 3650-3700 MHz band, and notify the registered users in the proposed geographic areas prior to operation in this band.
- (5) Further requests for extension of the authority granted herein must be filed on Form 442, "Application for New or Modified Radio Station Authorization under Part 5 of FCC Rules - Experimental Radio Service." Future STA requests to extend this authorization will not be considered.
- (6) Prior to operation, experimental licensee, must notify licensees of FSS earth stations operating above 3625 MHz within 15-kilometer radius of the locations from which experimental operations will occur. Experimental licensee, must also provide such notification to the National Spectrum Managers Association frequency coordinators by email: (see http://wireless.fcc.gov/services/index.htm?job=licensing_1&id=microwave). The notice must include the name and contact information of the stop buzzer personnel that will be available to cease operations in the event of reported interference. The notification should include the testing parameters (specific location(s), antenna gain(s), antenna pattern, antenna height(s), antenna orientation, eirp density) and day and times of each test. Consult the IBFS database to identify licensed earth station in the band 3625-4200 MHz band.
