- (1) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (2) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (3) Prior coordinate with the local SBE frequency coordinator prior to operation in 2412-2462 MHz band.
- (4) Prior coordinate with Fixed Microwave Service licensees prior to operation in 27.5-28.35 GHz and 2412-2462 MHz bands.
- (5) Further requests for extension of the authority granted herein must be filed on Form 442, "Application for New or Modified Radio Station Authorization under Part 5 of FCC Rules - Experimental Radio Service." Future STA requests to extend this authorization will not be considered.
- (6) Operation is not permitted in 5600-5650 MHz band to protect air traffic operations.
