- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (4) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by National Science Foundation contract numbers NSF-AGS-1361237. The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized. Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above.
- (5) Operations under the authority of this assignment are subject to immediate adjustment, including cessation, if they result in harmful interference to airborne weather radars.
- (6) Due to anticipated harmful interferences operation is not permitted in the 5590-5610 MHz band.
