Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (3) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (4) All customers participating in the experiment shall be informed that this operation is for experimental purposes only and can be cancelled at any time.
- (5) Prior to equipment authorization or a determination of compliance, the device must be accompanied by a conspicuous notice worded as follows: "This device has not been authorized as required by the rules of the Federal Communications Commission. This device is not, and may not be, offered for sale or lease, or sold or leased, until authorization is obtained."
- (6) Licensee must respond to interference complaints in a timely manner.
- (7) CISPR quasi-peak measurements are to be taken in the linear mode only.
- (8) This license authorizes the use of no more than 500 units at any time.
- (9) The PROGRESS REPORT should include, but is not limited to, a description of measurements and results demonstrating compliance with Part 15.109.
- (10) Licensee is required to file a PROGRESS REPORT at the completion of testing. This progress report shall be filed with Federal Communications Commission; Experimental Licensing Branch, MS 1300E1; 445 12 Street, S.W.; Washington, DC 20554 or uploaded electronically via the OET Experimental Licensing Branch's Electronic Filing Web Site at https://gulfoss2.fcc.gov/prod/oet/index_els.html by using the "Add Attachments" feature.
