5.9-7.125 GHz
10.7-11.7 GHz
17.7-19.7 GHz
21.2-23.6 GHz
24.25-25.25 GHz
27.5-28.35 GHz
29.1-29.25 GHz
31-31.3 GHz
36-40 GHz

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application.
