- (5) Operation is limited to activity for the purpose of testing radionavigation satellite service (RNSS) equipment and systems.
- (6) This frequency assignment on 1227.6 MHz was coordinated prior to authorization with the FAA Southern Coordinator, Atlanta, Georgia. Use of this frequency under the authority of this assignment is subject to such further coordination with the FAA Southern Coordinator, Atlanta, Georgia, as necessary to ensure compatibility with existing uses.
- (7) Licensee is required to post signs on doors to the testing area notifying that, "GPS re-radiator is in use and the GPS information you receive may be in error."
- (8) No EIRP greater than -140 dBm/24 MHz at 100 feet is used.
- (9) The test equipment shall only be used in doors and shall be under the control of Cessna Aircraft Company.
