The equipment to be tested is HF radios and antennas installed in general aviation aircraft developed, produced and sold by Cessna Aircraft Company. All radios are FCC type accepted under Part 87. The tests are for EMI/EMC purposes, and must be performed in order to receive FAA and foreign certifications for new aircraft configurations prior to delivery of the aircraft.

The continuous introduction of new aircraft models, HF radio and antenna models and custom configurations will require occasional testing for years to come. We anticipate only a few tests per year. To minimize repetitious STAs we plan to file for an experimental license soon. In order to accommodate any popup tests that may occur during the interim, we are filing for an extension of the current STA with a six month term.
