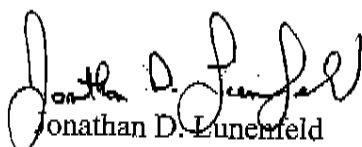
Dear Mr. Hankins:

This letter is ARINC Frequency Management's (FM) response to your pending FCC application to operate on primary and adjacent frequencies between 131.250 and 131.300 MHz at Mid Continent Airport (ICT).

FM has reviewed the pending application and has determined that Cessna may conduct their tests as long as the transmissions are conducted in the aircraft while on the ground. Since the experimental licenses are assigned on a secondary non-interference basis, FM expects Cessna to immediately cease all transmissions if harmful interference should occur to any ARINC operations.
