The FAA rejected the following frequencies, with reasons in parentheses: 327.050 MHz (ATC channel), 330.050 MHz (Glide Slope Channel), 330.300 MHz (Glide Slope Channel), 330.550 MHz (Glide Slope Channel), 330.650 MHz (Glide Slope Channel), 330.900 MHz (Glide Slope Channel), 331.150 MHz (Glide Slope Channel), 331.250 MHz (Glide Slope Channel), 331.500 MHz (Glide Slope Channel) and 331.750 MHz (Glide Slope Channel).

Please advise on how you would like to proceed. Your options are to accept use of the approved frequencies and not operate on the rejected frequencies or to plead your case with the FAA over the rejected frequencies.

The items indicated above must be submitted before processing can continue on the above referenced application. Failure to provide the requested information within 30 days of November 20, 2002 may result in application dismissal pursuant to Section 5.67 and forfeiture of the filing fee pursuant to Section 1.1108.
