Mike,

Per our discussion we are requesting coordination for three UHF frequencies to use in aircraft UHF comm radio configuration certifications and for operational checks on production aircraft. A complete description of the proposed operations, frequencies, transceivers and antennas is contained in the attached MS Word document. If it will cause too much trouble or delay in getting approval, we would just go with the 6K00A3E emission designator, ARC 159 ground radio at 20 W, and KTR-909B aircraft radio at 20 W for now. This is the configuration we will use for next round of tests, and we can see about a modification to accomodate the other equipment later.

Have also attached the brochure for the V/UHF Defense transceiver that we plan to purchase when it becomes available later this year. It is the Park Air M7X. Verra Nice!
