WARNING

Discontinue operation immediately should the equipment fail to function in a normal manner.

Do not tamper with equipment.

Don't make unnecessary transmissions. Remember that Citizens Radio communications are in a "party line" system which requires cooperation of all users to avoid interference.

The transmission of profane, indecent, or obscene language is prohibited.

You may not engage in either broadcasting or in communications for hire.

When you change your permanent address, you must obtain a new license showing your new address.

It's your responsibility to see that the station is properly operated at all times.

Keep informed. Your license may be revoked for failure to comply with the law and the Commission's Rules and Regulations.

For Class C stations, the maximum plate power input to the final radio frequency stage is 5 watts.

This license shall not vest in the licensee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of any frequency or band of frequencies beyond the expiration date thereof. This license may be assigned or otherwise transferred only in accordance with the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and is further subject to the possible assertion of superior rights by the United States conferred by Section 606 of the same Act.

10. Technical data to be supplied for non-type-approved equipment—

An applicant for a Citizens Radio Station who proposes to use or operate equipment which has not been type-approved by FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION must supplement his application with data which will enable the Commission to determine that the equipment complies with either Class A, Class B, or Class C station requirements, as appropriate, in accordance with all provisions of Part 19 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations. This technical data is not required for Class C stations, if crystal controlled.

Item 1. Print in ink or type the name and address of the applicant in this space.
