This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

Special Conditions:

- (1) Operation in the 1695-1780 MHz, 1915-1920 MHz, 1995-2020 MHz or 2110-2200 MHz band requires consent of local Advanced Wireless Service (AWS) licensee(s) to avoid interference.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (4) Experimental station shall use the minimum power level necessary to establish communications links to minimize potential interference to licensed users.
- (5) This authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future experimental satellite earth station applications.
- (6) Consult the ULS database to ensure that the operation will not cause harmful interference to any existing registered stations in the 3650-3700 MHz band, and notify the registered users in the proposed geographic areas.
- (7) Maintain operation separation from the grandfathered earth stations as defined in Part 90, Subpart Z, or coordinate an agreement with the grandfathered earth station licensees prior to operation in 3300-3700 MHz band.

Special Conditions:

- (8) Coordinate with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers frequency coordinator prior to operation in 2025-2110 MHz, 2450-2483.5 MHz and 6425-7125 MHz bands.
- (9) Coordinate with affected Fixed Microwave Service licensees prior to operation in 2450-2483.5 MHz, 6425-7125 MHz and 11170-11720 MHz bands.
- (10) Prior to commencing any operations, the licensee must obtain consent from the following within 50 miles of the contours of the testing area:
 - 1390-92 MHz Band Licensees
 - 1392-1395 MHz/1432-1435 MHz Band licensees
 - 1670-1675 MHz Band licensee (Crown Castle International,) and the lessee (Ligado Networks)
 - Broadband PCS licensees (1850-1910 MHz/1930-1990 MHz)
 - WCS (2305-2320 MHz/2345-2360 MHz) licensee (AT&T)

- (12) All transmitting and/or receiving equipment shall be owned and retrieved by the licensee .
