Reapply of experimental radio station KB2XCA that was expired on May1, 1999.

The City of Los Angeles Department of Water and Power has installed two Magnavox Model MX 2400T satellite telephones on a fixed basis at our General Office Building (GOB) located in Los Angeles, California, and at our Energy Control Center (ECC) located in Sunland, California. The Department also owns three NEC INMARSAT-M Model D7346B and two Magnavox Model MX2020P portable satellite telephones. The Department plans to utilize all these units for disaster recovery applications.

These units were previously licensed under the experimental radio station KB2XCA that expired on May 1, 1999.

Enclosed are four FCC Form 442 applications for new experimental radio station authorizations for the use of these satellite telephones.
