NOTIFICATION FOR TIN INFORMATION

► The Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN) Registration (FCC Form 606) has been reviewed and contains incorrect and/or incomplete information.

☐ Please complete the enclosed FCC Form 606 for TIN Registration or file electronically via internet at <http://www.fcc.gov/wtb/uls> and select "ULS Call Sign Registration".

☐ Item 1 must be completed in accordance with the following: TINs are 9-digit identifiers required of all individuals and employers to identify their tax accounts. Individuals use their Social Security Numbers as their TIN. Employers use their Employer Identification Number (EIN), sometimes referred to as Federal Identification Numbers (FIN), as their TIN. EINs are issued by the IRS to all employers whether or not they pay taxes. This includes corporations, sole proprietors, partnerships, state/local government agencies, limited liability companies, non-profit organizations, and federal government/military agencies. Each employer and individual has one TIN which uniquely identifies it.

► NOTE: The TIN number to be listed in Item 1 is NOT your State Sales Tax Exemption Number, nor is it your Federal Excise Number.

☐ Item 22 of the FCC Form 606 must be completed with all associated Call Signs that are licensed to your entity. If you are not sure what the call signs are, please provide a copy(s) of your license(s). If your license is no longer valid or no longer in use, you are not required to register your TIN; however, please notify the Commission that you wish to cancel the appropriate license(s).

☒ According to our records, the attached call sign report (marked "Not WTB" - Invalid Wireless call sign, "Name mismatch" or "Deleted/Purged") indicates call signs that you listed on your FCC Form 606 which do not exist for your entity. Please verify your call signs to ensure that your filing is accurate. If the call signs that you included in your FCC Form 606 are correct, please provide either a copy of your license(s), or a copy of the FCC Public Notice announcing the grant of the call sign(s). Please make the appropriate corrections and/or supply the required information and resubmit this Return Notice and all attachments. Once we receive the documentation we will update our records and register the call sign(s).

☐ ► If your TIN information was electronically submitted to the FCC, you must update your information via the Internet at <http://www.fcc.gov/wtb/uls> (first select "ULS Call Sign Registration" and then select either "Update Registration Information" or "Update Call Sign Information", use your previously self-assigned password).

☒ ► For call signs marked "Name Mismatch": You must clarify the reason for the discrepancy of the licensee name in the Taxpayer Identification Number (TIN) database and the FCC License Database.

(1) If the name mismatch is due to a change in ownership, corporate structure, or control, you must submit the required modification application as required by Commission Rules. (2) If the name mismatch is due to the call signs being licensed to a subsidiary of your company, they should be filed separately indicating the Taxpayer Identification Number and Entity Name under which these call signs have been issued.

☐ Your previous TIN Registration information was electronically submitted to the FCC. Attached is the Licensee and Contact Name and Address information of the electronic filer. The enclosed FCC Form 606 was mailed to our office. Please verify that the call signs listed on this Form 606 are to be associated with your TIN information.
