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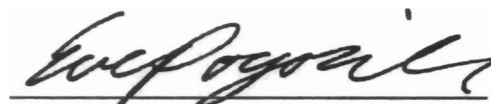

Dear Ms. Dortch:

As the Association for Maximum Service Television, Inc. ("MSTV") has previously documented,¹ the Commission should deny the meritless Application for Review filed by Clarity Media Systems, LLC ("Clarity"). Clarity's recent request for an experimental license (File No. 0692-EX-PL-2007) is fatally flawed, and does not change the fact that its plan to create a wireless cable service in the spectrum used for the public's electronic newsgathering ("ENG") service would not be in the public interest. MSTV submits this *ex parte* letter so that the record in this proceeding reflects the serious flaws in Clarity's experimental application. See Attachment 1.
