The purpose of a nationwide license is to allow us to test the units under actual field conditions and to do customer demonstrations. Clear-Com is asking to transfer the name and engineering of products that were manufactured by Vega in El Monte, California. We plan to use the experimental license exactly the way they did.

These products are wireless intercoms and wireless microphones for use in the broadcast and entertainment industries. Demonstration and testing of these units would only be temporary in several of the major markets such as New York City, Los Angeles, Tampa Florida, San Francisco, and others. Rarely would there be more than one unit out in the field for this purpose at any given time.
