Dear Dr. Kluth:

Concordia University Texas ("Concordia") is the licensee of EBS Station WLX201. Station WLX201 is subject to a grandfathered lease with NSAC, LLC, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Clearwire Corporation ("Clearwire"). Pursuant to that lease, Clearwire is requesting Concordia's consent to Clearwire's use of EBS Station WLX201 for twelve months in association with an experimental application to be filed with the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") by another wholly-owned subsidiary of Clearwire, Clearwire Spectrum Holdings III, LLC.

By its signature below, Concordia hereby consents to Clearwire's use of EBS Station WLX201 for twelve months to trial a new radio product, operating in the 2.4-2.6 GHz band, which is designed to provide in-building broadband wireless services. Clearwire agrees to operate on the EBS Station WLX201 in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Federal Communications Commission, and the terms of the existing lease between the parties, and to take all necessary steps to cause no interference to any current operations and to protect and preserve the status of EBS Station WLX201. There will be no commercial use of the spectrum pursuant to this experimental application. Concordia believes that its participation in this trial will benefit it and other EBS licensees. The parties acknowledge that this letter will be attached to the experimental application to be filed by Clearwire with the FCC's Office of Engineering and Technology.
