Re: **EXPERIMENTAL SPECIAL TEMPORARY AUTHORIZATION**
Consent to Use of EBS Channels G1 and G2

Dear Dr. Licopoli:

Mineola Union Free School District ("Mineola") is the licensee of EBS Station KNZ71. Station KNZ71 is subject to a grandfathered lease with NSAC, LLC, which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Clearwire Corporation ("Clearwire"). Pursuant to that lease, Clearwire is requesting Mineola's consent to Clearwire's use of EBS Channels G1 and G2 for six months in association with an application for Experimental Special Temporary Authority to be filed with the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") by another wholly-owned subsidiary of Clearwire, Clearwire Spectrum Holdings III, LLC.

By its signature below, Mineola hereby consents to Clearwire's use of EBS Channels G1 and G2¹ for six months to validate the effectiveness and coverage of an in-building WiMAX system and to gather field performance data. This experiment will assist Clearwire in extending the WiMAX wireless broadband experience to in-building users.

Clearwire agrees to take all necessary steps to cause no interference to any current operations of EBS Station KNZ71. There will be no commercial use of the spectrum pursuant to this experimental application. Mineola believes that its consent to this trial will benefit it and other EBS licensees. The parties acknowledge that this letter will be attached to the application for Experimental Special Temporary Authority to be filed by Clearwire with the FCC's Office of Engineering and Technology.

¹ The Spectrum for which consent is being given in this letter includes the following frequencies: G1 (002673.50000-002679.00000 MHz) and G2 (002679.00000-002684.50000 MHz). The FCC mandated transition has been completed for the station, and the Transition Completion Notice has been filed, but the post transition minor modification application has not yet been filed.
