- (4) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (5) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.

- (11) Operation in 80-640 MHz is subject to immediate cessation if it causes harmful interference to Air Force, Army, Navy, Marine Corps or FAA.
- (12) Operation is prohibited in 24.99-25.01 MHz band.
- (13) Operation in Band 14 (758-769 MHz and 788-799 MHz) is prohibited.
