- (2) Operation is subject to prior coordination with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers, Inc. (SBE) frequency coordinator. Consult the list at http://freq.sbe.org/pdf_files/coordinators.pdf to find the appropriate coordinator.
- (3) Licensee is required to coordinate operations with existing microwave users in the area to avoid interference.
- (4) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (5) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (6) Operation is subject to prior coordination with the local SBE representative to protect any possible Broadcast Auxiliary Services licensees in the 2025-2110 MHz band.
- (7) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application. Any launch monitoring will require a Special Temporary Authorization from the Commission's International Bureau.
