RE: FCC File #: 0229-EX-PL-2002 for Georgetown, NJ

CenGen Inc. is engaged in several government sponsored (e.g. Office of Naval Research (ONR), Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency (DARPA), etc.) and Internal Research and Development (IRAD)) efforts to advance wireless communications.

The existing CenGen FCC licenses for operations in the 2.4 GHz band cannot be used to satisfy the current request for a license for the Georgetown, NJ location. CenGen normally works as part of a larger team and has a requirement to conduct testing at numerous locations. The change in location is required for a variety of reasons including many that impact the Radio Frequency components of the testing (e.g. terrain, foliage, and weather).

The current license requested a radius of 500 km. CenGen can reduce the scope of that radius. CenGen requests a desired radius of 100 km and a minimum radius of 50 km.
