MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

The County of Los Angeles ("the County") hereby requests a twenty-one (21) day extension of time, until October 25, 1999, to file an Opposition to the Informal Objection submitted by American Radio Relay League, Incorporated ("ARRL") on September 23, 1999, regarding the above-captioned applications of the County.

The Informal Objection raises a series of complex technical issues which require the analysis of the County's engineering staff. The current deadline for filing an Opposition to the ARRL Informal Objection is October 4, 1999. That does not permit adequate time for the necessary engineering analysis and preparation of a technical response. Furthermore, the County's engineering staff is currently engaged in a number of time sensitive matters and therefore is unable to devote adequate resources to this project at this time.

Therefore, a brief extension of time will facilitate the compilation of a more complete record, without delaying Commission consideration of this matter. The County

respectfully requests an additional twenty-one (21) days to submit its Opposition to the Informal Objection. The new due date would be October 25, 1999.

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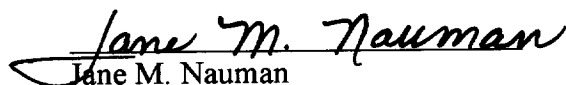
