MOTION FOR FURTHER EXTENSION OF TIME

The County of Los Angeles ("the County") hereby requests an additional thirty (30) day extension of time, until November 24, 1999, to file an Opposition to the Informal Objection submitted by American Radio Relay League, Incorporated ("ARRL") on September 23, 1999, regarding the above-captioned applications of the County.

The Informal Objection raises a series of complex technical issues that require further analysis by the County's engineering staff. The current deadline for filing an opposition to the ARRL Informal Objection is October 25, 1999, which does not permit adequate time for the necessary engineering analysis and preparation of a technical response. The County's engineering staff is currently engaged in a number of time sensitive matters and therefore is unable to devote adequate resources to this project at this time.

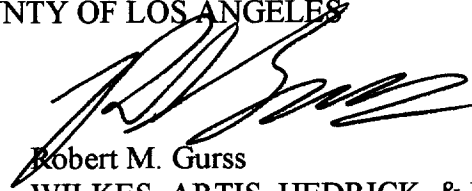

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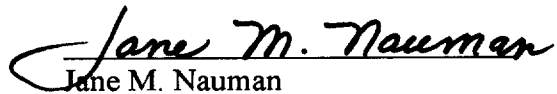
