GAFC concurs with the condition that discrete frequencies will be selected where the occupied emission bandwidth will not exceed the authorized band edges: GAFC 17-216/RM.

NOTE: Be advised Pensacola Navy missions operating in central Alabama MOAs (Camden, Pine Hill, etc.) could potentially cause interference in 1435.0 - 1450.0 MHz during weekdays.
