Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Operation is subject to prior coordination with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers, Inc. (SBE) frequency coordinator. Consult the list at <http://sbe.org/resources/frequency-coordination/> to find the appropriate coordinator.
- (3) Licensee must notify the 600 Megahertz Band licensees (Service Code: WT) in each proposed area prior to accessing to the 614-617 MHz and 652-663 MHz bands.
- (4) Prior to commencing any operations in the frequencies below, Licensee must obtain consent from the following within 20 miles of the contours of the testing area:
 - 700 MHz Guard Band licensees (757-758 MHz/787-788 MHz)
 - 700 MHz Guard Band licensees (775-776 MHz/805-806 MHz)
- (5) Operations within part 90 bands must comply with all applicable rules under par 90, including but not limited to, the requirements for protecting centralized trunked incumbents as specified in section 90.187.
