This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

Special Temporary Authority is hereby granted to operate the apparatus described below:

Special Conditions:

- (1) All transmitting and/or receiving equipment used in the study shall be owned by the licensee.
- (2) Licensee is required to ensure that trial devices are either rendered inoperable or retrieved by them from trial participants at the conclusion of the trial. Licensee is required to notify trial participants in advance that operation of the trial device is subject to this condition.
- (3) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (4) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (5) This coordination does give requester exclusive use of the coordinated bands. Due to high demand for STA coordination for this event, as in previous years all requests will receive band assignments. For Super Bowl play, the on site NFL Spectrum coordinator will assign individual assignments to those with valid AFTRCC coordinations and FCC STA's. For pre-game events, those companies having valid AFTRCC coordinations will be requested to coordinate a spectrum usage plan among themselves. If one cannot be negotiated among the individual companies than the AFTRCC coordinator will assign individual frequencies.
