This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) CP Communications, LLC should be aware that the requested location falls within the Exclusion Zone defined in the NTIA Fast Track Report (NTIA Technical Report TR-15-517: 3.5 GHz Exclusion Zone Analyses and Methodology). NTIA's concurrence is based upon CP Communications, LLC's understanding that their operations are susceptible to interference from federal operations and they agree to accept any interference should it occur as well as operating on a Non-Interference Basis to any federal systems in the requested area.
- (4) Prior to commencing any operations in the frequencies below, the applicant must obtain consent from the following within 50 miles of the contours of the testing area:
 - > 700 MHz Lower Band "C" block licensees (710-716 MHz/740-746 MHz)
 - > 700 MHz Lower Band "D" block licensees (716-722 MHz)
 - > 700 MHz Lower Band "E" block licensees (722-728 MHz)
- (5) CP Communications, LLC. shall prior coordinate with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers to protect the Low Power Broadcast Auxiliary operations on 476-482 MHz, 506-512 MHz & 714-725 MHz. Consult the list at https://www.sbe.org/sections/freq_local.php to find the appropriate coordinator.
- (6) All of the experimental devices will be under control of CP Communications, LLC. and they will be retrieved by CP Communications, LLC. from the participants upon completion of the experiment.
